

SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of Hevey Civil Engineering to attach the greatest importance to the health and safety of all persons employed on any project and indirectly affected by the works. The project will be constructed, so far as is reasonably practicable, in such a way that the risks to the health and safety of all persons engaged in, or affected by, its construction and maintenance are eliminated or reduced to an acceptable level under current health and safety legislation and good practice.

All persons involved with any project have a duty to comply with the Safety and Health Plan and with any directions given to them by the Project Supervisor for Construction. Any PSCS document will remain active throughout the lifespan of each project and will contain the forms required to execute effective safety management over the course of the project.

A Site Specific Safety Statement shall be brought to the attention of all employees, full time or temporary. This Safety Statement outlines safe systems of work, workplace/site hazards and is meant to be brought to the attention of all management and employees of Hevey Civil Engineering , to outline any duties/procedures to be followed so as to comply with any relevant legislation, in particular the 2005 Act, the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work(Construction) Regulations 2013 and the General Application Regulations 2016.

It is the intention of Hevey Civil Engineering to comply with all relevant legislation and provide employees with a safe working environment and also protect those who may be affected by our activities from harm. All employees will be expected to comply with policies and procedures as described in relevant sections of the Safety Statement and Construction Stage Health and Safety Plan.
